PRIVACY AND COOKIE POLICY

We are Zhongshan SEEMAX Electrical Appliance Co., Ltd, (for purposes of this policy, all of our entities and brands are referred to as "SEEMAX").

SEEMAX values your privacy. In this Privacy Policy ("Policy"), we describe how we collect, use, and disclose information that we obtain about visitors to this website, as well as our other websites (collectively, the "Site") and the services available through our Site (collectively, the "Services"). Some features and functionalities (e.g. the ability to make purchases) are not available on all of our websites; please contact us if you have any questions.

By visiting the Site, or using any of our Services, you agree that your personal information will be handled as described in this Policy. Your use of our Site or Services, and any dispute over privacy, is subject to this Policy and our Terms of Service (available on this website), including its applicable limitations on damages and the resolution of disputes. The Terms of Service are incorporated by reference into this Policy.

What Information Do We Collect About You?

What Information Do We Collect About You?

We collect information directly from users, such as when they sign up to receive special offers from us or register for an account with us. We also collect certain information automatically through your use of our Site or Services.

Information You Provide

We collect information that you enter on our Site or provide to us in any other way. We collect information from you when you make a purchase from us, create an account (offered as a convenience to customers but not required), request information, submit a review, or otherwise contact us. The type of information that we collect from you depends on your interaction with our Site and your use of our Services, but may include: full name, mailing address, billing address, telephone number, email address, payment information (for purchases), social media account name, social media account handle, birth month, gender, age range, location data, and any other information that you choose to provide.

Information We Collect Automatically

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies (or similar tracking technologies designed for mobile devices) are simple text files stored on your computer or mobile device when you visit certain web pages. A cookie records basic information about your visit, such as your user settings or what pages you have viewed. The website (and potentially other websites) can then recognise this information in the future and can use it to improve your overall experience, for example, by remembering your log-in details, preferences or even recommending certain content.

There Are Four Principle Types Of Cookie, Which Perform Different Functions. The Main Types Are:

- 1. Essential cookiesSome cookies are essential for the operation of a website, and without these cookies the website would not be able to perform certain necessary functions. An example of this is where a shopping website uses cookies to remember products placed into an online shopping basket. Without using these cookies, it would not be possible to shop online.
- 2. Performance cookiesPerformance cookies collect information about how a website is used in order to improve the website's effectiveness. Also known as 'analytical' cookies, performance cookies track information such as, which parts of the website have been visited, what links have been clicked and if any errors have occurred. Performance cookies are commonly used to ensure that popular content is displayed more prominently on a website so that users can find the information that they are looking for more quickly.
- 3. Functionality cookiesAs the name suggests, 'functionality' cookies are used to deliver specific features or functions on a website. The most common use of functionality cookies is to remember preference settings, or to store log-in details. HOW LONG DO COOKIES LAST?

Cookies may stay on your computer or mobile device for different periods of time depending on what they are used for. Many cookies will only last for the duration of a single visit and will be automatically deleted when the browser is closed down or the computer is turned off. These cookies are known as 'session' cookies. We use session cookies to allow our systems to uniquely identify you during a session or while you are logged into our website. This allows us to process your online transactions and requests and verify your identity, after you have logged in, as you move through our website.

Some cookies (known as 'persistent' cookies) do remain on your device between sessions and allow us to authenticate you and to remember your preferences. Persistent cookies will remain on your computer after you have closed the browser or turned off the computer. We use persistent cookies to track aggregate and statistical information about user activity and to display advertising on our website and on third party websites.

WHAT DO WE USE COOKIES FOR?

Orolay does not store personally identifiable information such as credit card details in cookies we create, but we do use encrypted information gathered from them to help improve your experience of the Orolay websites.

Remember the products you have stored in your basket in case you want to return and purchase them at a later date

Identify you when you sign-in to one of our websites, which enables us to provide customised features and services, such as adding items to your wish list

Conduct research and diagnostics to improve our content, products and services to you

Prevent fraudulent activities

Improve security

Make it easier for you to navigate our websites and services
